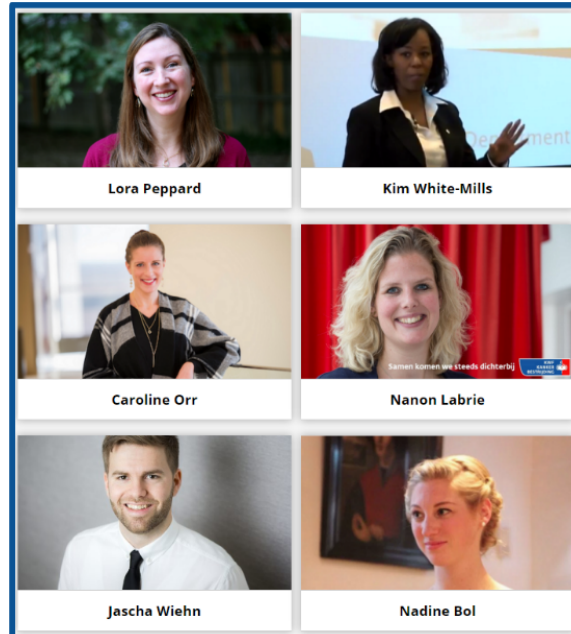

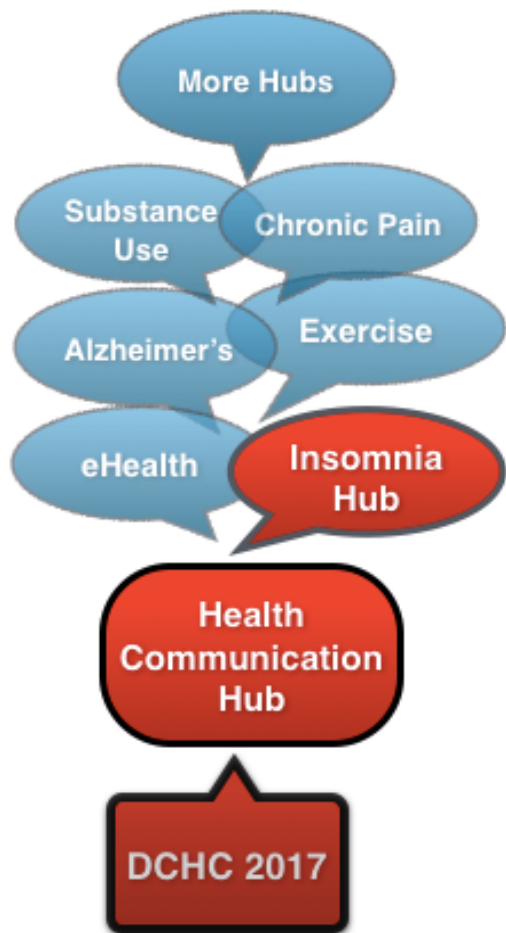

Promote your research

Share your Knowledge ...

Gary Kreps, our Lead Advisor, is assisting in pioneering the Open Network (ON) of Health Hubs. The Health Communication Hub is the first of its kind for a *discipline* and the Insomnia Hub is the first Hub for a *condition* (insomnia.onair.cc).

These knowledge Hubs are co-created & curated by members of the non-profit Open Network Alliance (ONA). Together, we *openly* promote evidence-based knowledge, for the greater health for all.

'Open' means all content is under the Creative Commons-Non Commercial (CC-NC) license.

... Have influence in health

CC-NC means we permit others to share our work (with attribution), but not earn money from it.

DCHC is the vanguard ONA member group. You can be an Author, Curator, Aircaster, or even a Hub manager. No expertise in technology is needed.
